



But what about theVeterinarians in my community –won't they hate us?


Communicate!

- Who is helping you?

- Consumer Reports
  - Sticker Shock prevents pets from getting vaccines/vet visits
- The good and bad of overpopulation – lots of clients for everyone!



### Organization – When?

- Schedule the initial one 3 months out
  - Start Small
  - Short Time 2 hours
- Use a consistent schedule if possible
  - Every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month



- Think Assembly Line...
  - Line Formation
    - Filling in Paperwork while in line
  - Check-in Area
    - Review Paperwork and Medical Records
    - Accept Payment/Issue Receipts
    - Hand client form to present to vet tech
  - One-on-One Animal Care
    - Administer Vaccines/Testing
    - Answer Questions & Assess Animal Health
  - Rabies Certification and/or Licensing Area
    - Offer to fax or email to speed up process

- Space Considerations
  - Quiet place for stressed cats to wait
  - Quiet place for procedures for stressed animals in general
  - Waiting area for test results
  - Areas that don't allow for a lot of animal to animal interaction
  - Owners who need a better handle on their animals and how to assist
  - Weather conditions


